

Joint AGS/SRGC Shows

The AGS organises three shows in conjunction with the SRGC each year in Kendal, Northumberland and Newcastle.

The show rules and notes of each Society are applied in alternate years, with the award of Farrer and Forrest medals as appropriate. It is important that exhibitors and judges recognise that there are a few key differences between the rules of each Society and that they should therefore consult and apply the appropriate rules. The key difference is in the definitions used for bulbous plants. For example, the AGS rules allow for rhizomes, as in Iris and Trillium, but exclude Cyclamen, whereas the SRGC rules allow for Cyclamen and Rhodohypoxis, but exclude Trillium and Oncoclycus Iris. If in doubt as to the suitability of a plant for a bulbous class please consult the Show Secretary, the Director of Shows or his representative.
